That's 24 out of 30 strikes (80% strike to ball ratio), all done going hard! In other words, as a rule of biomechanics, there is no slowing up. It's GO HARD or GO HOME. So, he was not going slow just to throw strikes. His improvement has been astounding. We could not be more proud of this young man. Congratulations, Jackson! You truly earned this honor!
